

Auxiliary Scholarship Guidelines

Scholarship application packets will be accepted beginning January 1.
All applications must be mailed to the post office box listed below.

Auxiliary Scholarships are directed to students who have demonstrated a favorable academic track record and who have a strong interest in pursuing a healthcare career.

Post-secondary students must permanently reside in the CDH/Delnor primary service area:

Addison, Aurora, Bartlett, Batavia, Bloomingdale, Carol Stream, Campton Hills, Elburn, Geneva, Glen Ellyn, Glendale Heights, Hanover Park, Kaneville, Lisle, Lombard, Naperville, North Aurora, Roselle, South Elgin, St. Charles, Villa Park, Warrenville, Wasco, Wayne, West Chicago, Wheaton and Winfield.

High School Seniors must be one of the three (3) students nominated by their guidance departments and must permanently reside within the CDH/Delnor Primary service area and attend one of the following schools:

Batavia, Benet Academy, Geneva, Glenbard North, Glenbard East, Glenbard South, Glenbard West, Kaneland, Montini Catholic, St. Charles North, St. Charles East, St. Francis, West Chicago Community, Wheaton Academy, Wheaton North, Wheaton-Warrenville South. Scholarships are given for one (1) academic year. Recipients may re-apply yearly.

Post-Secondary Requirements:

- Applicants must have a minimum GPA of 3.2 on a 4.0 scale or a GPA of 4.0 on a 5.0 scale.
- All applicants must provide current transcripts. All transcripts must be mailed directly to the Scholarship Committee Chairman by the appropriate school or institution. See address below.
- College freshman must also submit high school transcripts.

The following must be mailed in a single envelope to the Scholarship Chairman:

- An application form must be completed. [Download scholarship application here.](#)
- Each application must include a personal statement reflecting the applicant's interest and qualifications for choosing a healthcare career.
- All applicants must provide two (2) letters of recommendation.
- One letter should be from a teacher, counselor or employer.
- The second letter may be a personal recommendation from someone other than a family member.

High School Requirements:

- All applicants must be one of the three (3) students recommended by their guidance department.** Maximum of three (3) applicants from each high school within the CDH/Delnor primary service area. The guidance department should mail the names of the 3 recommendations directly to the Scholarship Chairman.
- Applicants must have a minimum GPA of 3.2 on a 4.0 scale or a GPA of 4.0 on a 5.0 scale.
- All applicants must provide current transcripts. All transcripts must be mailed directly to the Scholarship Chairman by the high school registrar. See address below.

The following must be mailed in a single envelope to the Scholarship Chairman:
